## ALDO CIBIC

Aldo Cibic was born in Schio (Vicenza/ Italy) in 1955. His main activities today take place in Milan, following urban, architecture and interior projects, and Vicenza with CibicWorkshop involved in design and research, addressing the development of new design typologies. He also teaches at the Domus Academy, as part of the Industrial Design degree in the Faculty of Architecture at the Milan Polytechnic and as part of the Industrial Design degree in the Faculty of Design at the University of Architecture of Venice, as well as doing research on the relationship between design and society. He is Honorary Professor at Tongji University, Shanghai. In 2010 he was invited to La Biennale di Architettura di Venezia 2010 "People Meet in Architecture" directed by Japanese architect Kazuyo Sejima, with the project "Rethinking Happiness".
